Uffculme is a medium sized school situated in the heart of the village of Uffculme. The village is located on the beautiful Devon/Somerset border with easy motorway and rail access to the regional centres of Taunton and Exeter.

### **School Organisation**

Uffculme Primary School is an average size primary school serving the area around a large village. In July 2013, the school became part of Uffculme Academy Trust, in partnership with Uffculme School, an outstanding secondary school with some of the highest academic results in the country. We are now able to offer our children a high quality all-through experience from age 4 to 16 years. Pupils are taught in seven singled aged classes. The school has a roll of 215 pupils, of whom 35 are in receipt of pupil premium (approx. 16%). There is one child on an EHCP plan with a further 2 who receive Element 3 funding to support their additional needs and 22 children on our SEND register.
