Remote Learning

- Timetables and plans will be uploaded to the school website each week, or fortnightly.
- Children who complete their work will need to upload and send via the email function on DB Learning. Please do not send this work via the school office.
- Teachers will provide regular feedback to uploaded work between 9 – 3:30pm.
- Teachers will upload two videos every school day onto the blog section of DB Learning from next week.
- Teachers will reward effort by using the reward system within DB Learning.
- If parents need to contact teachers regarding the work, or any other issues, please email the school office.
- If children do not have their passwords, then please contact the school office.
- If you require an exercise book or any stationery, these will be available every day this week by the double gates at the front of the school between 10:30 – 2:30.
- If you are unable to access the internet, then please let the office know and we will provide a hard copy.
- Please continue to check the class blog regularly as teachers will be using the function.
- Children are able to contact the teachers through the email function on DB Learning.
